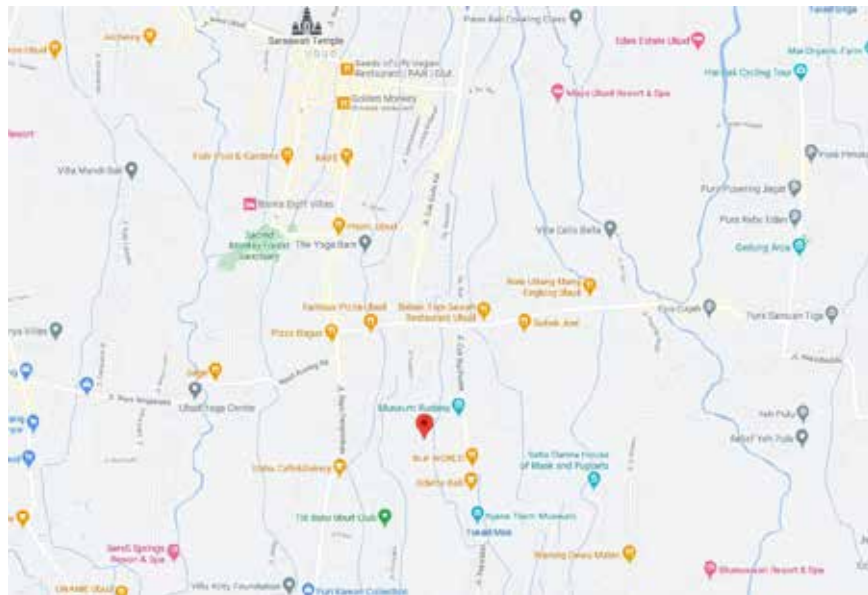

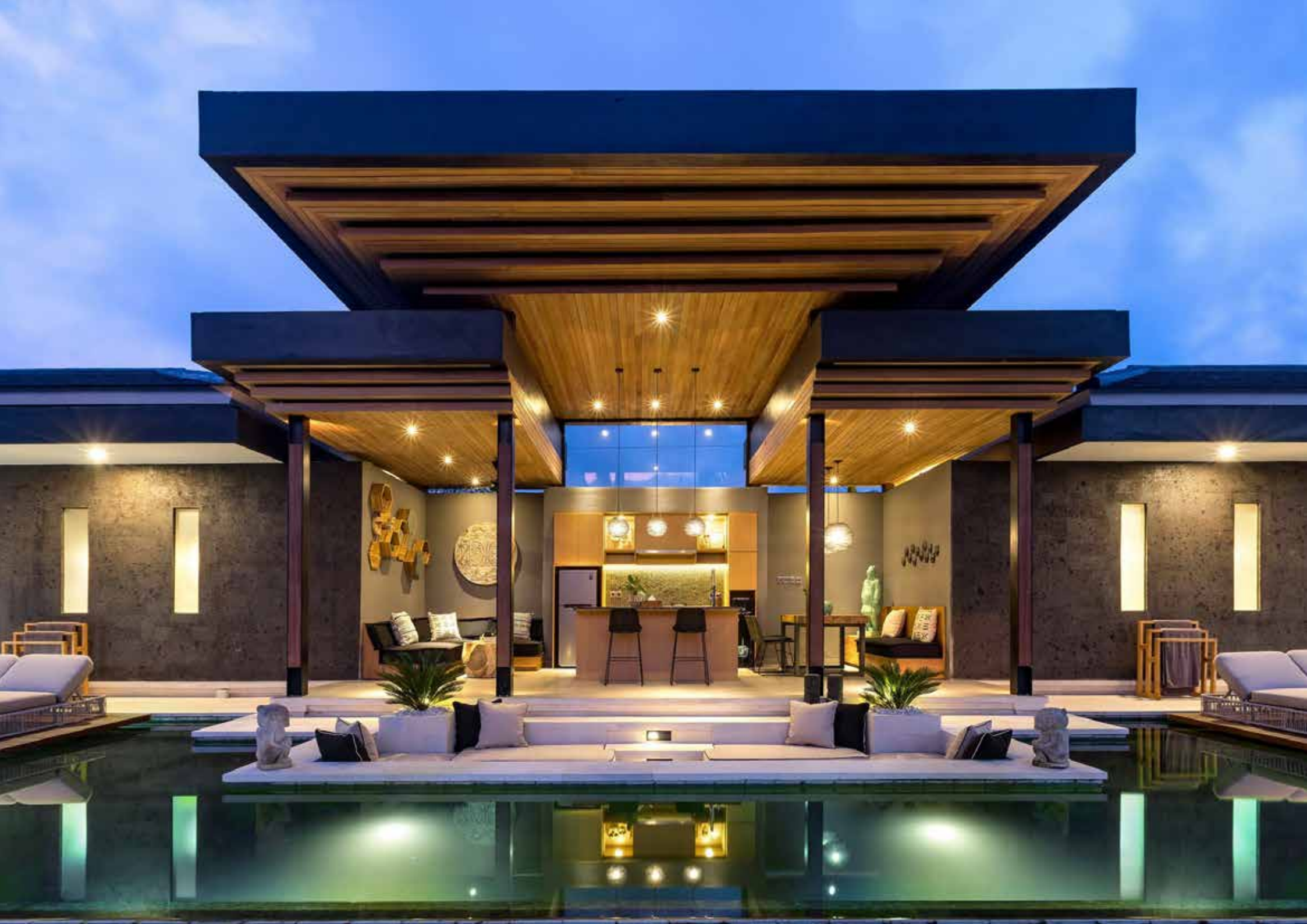

1. What are the little baskets on the street ? These are offerings to Hindu gods. An everyday ritual and you will see many in the streets. Don't step intentionally on it – it's bad Karma !



2. Restaurants generally serve food between 12pm-2:30pm and between 7pm-10pm. It is useful to know that cooking at home or eating out is pretty much the same price range!



3. If you have any doubts regarding the friendly side of the Balinese people: smile at them - you will see how cheerful they are! :)



4. A surf course is mandatory to pass your local grade. JUST KIDDING, but you will see that surfing is part of the - South Bali lifestyle. Get your boards!

# The Dos & Dont's

## The Dos

---

- Learn 2, 3 Balinese words or expressions. It is the best way to immerse yourself in the local culture:
  - **Terima kasih** (*Thank you*)                      - **Apa Kabar ?** (*How are you ?*)
  - **Selamat pagi !** (*Good morning*)           - **Baik** (*I'm fine*)
- Be aware of the monkeys in and around the Monkey Forest - they like to take your sunglasses ;)
- For your snack breaks and picnics, please make sure you don't leave any rubbish behind !
- When you buy products, give priority to local producers, talented designers & artists (visit the Ubud market for famous artisanal crafts) this way, you are supporting the local community and can bring a real piece of Bali culture home.
- It is important to respect certain rules in temples as well as on the road, as it might be quite different to what you are used to. Tolerance is a key to appreciation.

## The Dont's

---

- Possession and usage of drugs is strictly prohibited in Indonesia. Such crime is punishable by imprisonment or death. Any incident related to illegal drugs will result in an immediate expulsion from the villa without compensation nor refund.
- To be disrespectful towards the villa staff and people on the island. This is a bit NO GO for Balinese people, who are very friendly. Give them a smile - they will smile back !
- Don't just try ONE Balinese specialty, try them all! Nasi Campur, Beef Rendang and sweets. They are delicious !
- Never throw your cigarette butts on the ground - on the beach, in the water or in the streets, use a portable ashtray for your cigarettes !

## Swimming Pool Rules

Enjoy the large swimming pool in the villa. It will be cleaned and serviced 3 times a week. Please use the pool at your own risk. We highly recommend you to supervise your children at all times. Please contact us if you would like to install a pool fence for the safety of your children.



## Satellite TV

The villa is equipped with TVs. If you have any problems using it, please ask our staff to assist you.



### Safety Box

To protect your valuables, we provide a safety box. Please note that we cannot be responsible for stolen or lost belongings in the villa.



### Courtesy Note

Please respect your neighbors. We ask you to keep the noise at a reasonable level, especially when listening to music, or when you're leaving the villa. Everyone in the district is asked to lower the volume after 10pm, as the local authorities do not accept events or parties after this time. Thank you for your cooperation and understanding.



### Laundry Services

We can provide laundry service through a third party, please ask housekeeping for assistance. It usually takes 24 to 48 hours, the price will be calculated per piece.



### Housekeeping

The cleaning staff comes to the villa from 8 am to 4 pm everyday unless you request for more privacy. Bed sheets and towels will be changed every 3 days. All the linen and towels shall remain in the property at all times.



### Smoking Policy

Smoking is strictly prohibited indoors. Please use the outside areas for smoking, ashtrays are available.



### Heavy Rain

As we are 8 degrees south of the equator, heavy tropical rain can happen. The garden can get flooded pretty fast. But don't stress, it will dry quickly once the rain stops. You are welcome to close all open windows and doors and open the little drainage caps, located all around the garden, to evacuate the water faster.



**IF OPEN LIVING AREA:** Please clean up your food after eating to avoid attracting our wildlife friends around.

# Protect our beautiful island of Gods

As a small island with limited natural resources, Bali is very fragile. We would like to protect Bali and keep it safe. For this matter, we need your support and understanding to help the environment:

Air Conditioning is available in each bedroom of the villa. Please turn the AC off when you leave the room and ensure all doors and windows are closed while the AC is running. This way we can reduce our negative impact on the environment together.

AC and lights off: Please consider turning off the AC and lights when you are not using the space. FYI, AC will cool down the room within 15 minutes.

We provide a water dispenser with drinkable water in the kitchen for you to use in order to reduce plastic usage.





# Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner

For your breakfast at the villa, a menu has been especially created for you. Place your order and it will be directly delivered to your villa.

If you prefer, our staff can prepare an American or Indonesian Breakfast at the villa for 50.000 Rupiah per person + the grocery cost. We can also prepare for you a floating breakfast for 430.000 Rupiah for 4 persons.

Please make sure you do pre-order your breakfast to our butler at least one day in advance. For your lunch and dinner, many restaurants in Ubud are offering food delivery service.
