 S urfers: respect priority rules when you surf. This is for your own safety.

For your snack break and picnics, please make sure you don't leave any rubbish behind!

 W hen you buy products, give priority to local producers, talented designers & artists (visit a market, for example), this way, you are supporting the local community and bringing a real piece of Bali home.

It is important to respect certain rules in temples as well as on the road as it might be quite different to what you are used to. Tolerance is a key to appreciation.

The Don'ts

Don't just try ONE Balinese specialties, try them all! Nasi Campur, beef rendang and sweets. They are amazing!

At the beach, in the water or in the streets, use a portable ashtray for your cigarettes butts!

Possession and usage of drug is strictly prohibited in Indonesia. Such crime is punishable by imprisonment or death. Any incident related to illegal drugs will result in an immediate expulsion from the villa without compensation or refund.

Respect the villa staff and people on the island, at all times.


Air Conditioning

We provide laundry services through a third party please ask the maid for assistance. It usually takes 24 to 48 hours, price will be calculated per piece.

Courtesy Note



Please respect your neighbors. We ask that you keep the noise at a reasonable level, especially when listening to music, or when leaving the villa. Everyone in the district is asked to lower the volume after 10pm, as the local authorities do not accept events or parties after this time. Note for the Clubbers: there are plenty of clubs and bars in the main street steps away. Thank you for your cooperation and understanding.

Housekeeping



The cleaning staff comes to the villa from 7 am to 8 pm every day unless you request for more privacy. Bed sheets and towels will be changed every 3 days. All the linen and towels shall remain in the property at all times.

Smoking Policy



Smoking is strictly prohibited in the bedrooms. Please use the outside areas for smoking, ashtrays are available in the living room.

Heavy Rain



As we are 8 degree south of the equator, heavy tropical rain can happen. Garden can seem flooded pretty fast. But don't stress, it will dry quickly once the rain stops. You are welcome to lower the joglo's out- door curtains and open the little drainage caps, located all around the garden, to evacuate the water faster.

Protect Bali

As a small island with limited natural resources, Bali is very fragile. We would like to protect Bali and keep it safe. In this matter, we need your support and understanding to help protect the environment:

- · AC and lights off: please consider turning off the AC and lights when you are not using the space. AC will cool down the room within 15 minutes.
- · We provide a water dispenser with drinkable water in the kitchen for you to use, and to help reduce the use of plastic on the island.

Note: The villa is equipped with a special water filtration system to deliver the best quality of water possible. However, we do not recommend drinking water from the tap.

Meals preparation is not available at the property. However, our staff is always available to suggest some options around the island. Do not hesitate to reach out as the Island repletes with food options.

Transportation, Activities and Sightseeing



With no cars or taxis on the island (only the trucks that transport guests to their hotels) the only way to get around Nusa Lembongan is by scooter. With sometimes bumpy and windy roads, it's not for the fainthearted, so only hire your own if you've driven one before (and always wear a helmet!) Do not hesitate to approach our staff for the complete list of activities available. They'll be pleased to organize something for you.

Things to do

We are happy to provide you with information about nearby places of interests, and we will help arrange transport and make bookings if needed. Feel free to ask our staff about the local area as we all live nearby. We will be able to give you insights into some of the fascinating aspects of local living in Bali. In the meantime, here are a few suggestions:

. Discover Nusa Lembongan's beaches. Not all the great beaches of Bali are located on the Bali mainland. The Nusa Islands have a handfull of soft white-sand beaches great for sunbathing. Nusa Ceningan has stunning Mahana Point and Secret Beach. Lembongan beaches are Dream Beach, Mushroom Bay, Coconuts Beach, and Jungutbatu Beach.

2. Cliffs at Blue Lagoon Blue Lagoon is a stunning viewpoint and cliff jumping point on Nusa Ceningan. The silky blue water is wild and swimming near the coastline isn't recommended. The viewpoint goes all around the cliff and there is a small blowhole

5. **Beach clubs at Nusa Lembongan**. The Nusa Islands have beautiful beaches and the same goes for the beach clubs. Chill the afternoon at one of the many clubs and dip into their pool or the sea in front to cool down. The beach clubs are incredibly picturesque and some offer outstanding meals as well! On Nusa Lembongan visit Ginger and Jamu, Ohana's and Sandy Bay beach club. The Sand and Le Pirate Beach Club on Nusa Ceningan are a little more intimate and affordable to hang for the day.

4. Day trip to Nusa Penida

Nusa Penida is one of those places that, one day, will be featured in a movie scene. The 200-meter high cliffs (that you are able to hike down!) offer some of the most stunning views of Bali and is one of the things you must do in Bali! A single boat trip to Nusa Penida only takes 15 minutes and from there you can explore the island by car or motorbike - an easy but absolutely great thing to do from Nusa Lembongan.

6. Yellow Bridge

An icon for these two Nusa Islands is the Yellow suspension bridge connecting them. The bridge is just wide enough for two motorbikes to cross each other. In between the islands, at the location of the bridge it gets extremely low-tide during sunset. Sometimes as low so you could walk from one side to the other.

9. Dreampoint viewpoint –

A second great sunset point is Dreampoint on Nusa Ceningan located next to the hotel Twilight Huts Lembongan. The old tree and swing offer a good view and during low-tide, you are able to walk down and see the fisherman getting their catch of the day.

5. Lembongan Mangrove Boat

Tour Take a small boat or standup paddleboard through the mangrove forest on the north-east side of Nusa Lembongan. Enjoy the calming river ride, clear waters and serenity.

/ Dive or Snorkel with Manta Rays In between Nusa Ceningan and Nusa Penida are well-known diving and snorkeling spots to see Manta Rays, the Mola-Mola sunfish, and dolphins! A 20-minute boat ride from Nusa Lembongan gets you to the Manta Point. Get ready to dive into the water and be amazed by the size of these gentle giants. Respect their environment and make sure to never touch them.


O. **Devil's Tear** – Dangerous thing to do on Nusa Lembongan Experience the powerful waves crashing into the cliff sides on Lembongan islands. Devil's Tear is an impressive, somewhat dangerous, blowhole where the water can easily reach metershigh into the air. Please do not get too close to the edge.
